## Richard Language College and Bournemouth

## Course

### Level A1, A2 and B1 (IELTS 0-5.0 – TOEFL 310-520)

**Morning:** General English – Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing

**Afternoon:** Formal English Studies (part one) which provide a sound basis for success in the IELTS Test:

#### ***Formal English Studies (part one)***

Writing notes, letters (formal and informal), Reports and Transferring Information from one format to another; Proof reading and Correction Techniques; Giving Presentations; Developing Reading Techniques and Awareness of Text Structure.

### Level B2 and C1 (IELTS 5.0-7.0 – TOEFL 520-640)

**Morning:** General English – Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing

**Afternoon:** Formal English Studies (part two) which are ideal for both IELTS success and effective preparation for entry to British colleges and universities.

#### ***Formal English Studies (part two)***

Extensive listening to formal material, Note Taking Skills, Register Awareness Development, Making Presentations, Debating Discourse, Production of Formal Text Reports, Discursive Essays, Development of Awareness of Text Types and Structure to aid rapid information acquisition.

The Class Tutor is responsible for the class's progress and academic welfare. Homework is set and individual progress assessment at the weekly Teachers' Meeting. There is regular level testing and a two-weekly needs analysis and progress assessment with the Class Tutor.
