**Test Technique:** Topics & question types; Study techniques & management of time in the test; Skimming; Scanning; Guessing of unknown words; Describing graphical and tabular information (Task 1); Discursive essays; Writing (Task 2); Listening intensively to lectures; Talks; Conversation; Discussions; Role play; Description; Questioning; Speaking about given topics.

**Test Practice:** Using styles of texts likely to be met in the IELTS test; Writing text types commonly used in the test; Types of gap-filling; Diagrammatic exercises used in the test; Typical interview format
