Course

Maxima Intensive - AM

Maxima Intensive courses involve small-group teaching for adults, including company personnel. Lessons are based on an oral approach to language learning; reading and writing are used in a supportive role where necessary. We include a strong element to 'reactivate' the learner's knowledge of the essential structures of the language.

Full use is made of audio-visual resources and modern teaching methods. Each class sees more than one teacher a day to ensure a contrast of accent, delivery and approach. Courses are in 4-week modules with course start dates arranged to balance academic control with flexibility of arrival.

One-to-One - PM

The one teacher to one trainee formula means a highly intensive, flexible and well-organised teaching programme that does not waste any valuable time. The completion of the Needs Analysis Questionnaire and the Pre-Test allows the precise language aims of each trainee to be identified before arrival in the UK, so that an individual programme can be designed to obtain optimum results.
